"Let's have a conversation about gun safety," Officer Robinson said, his eyes shifting from one child to another. "It's important to know what to do if you come across a firearm."

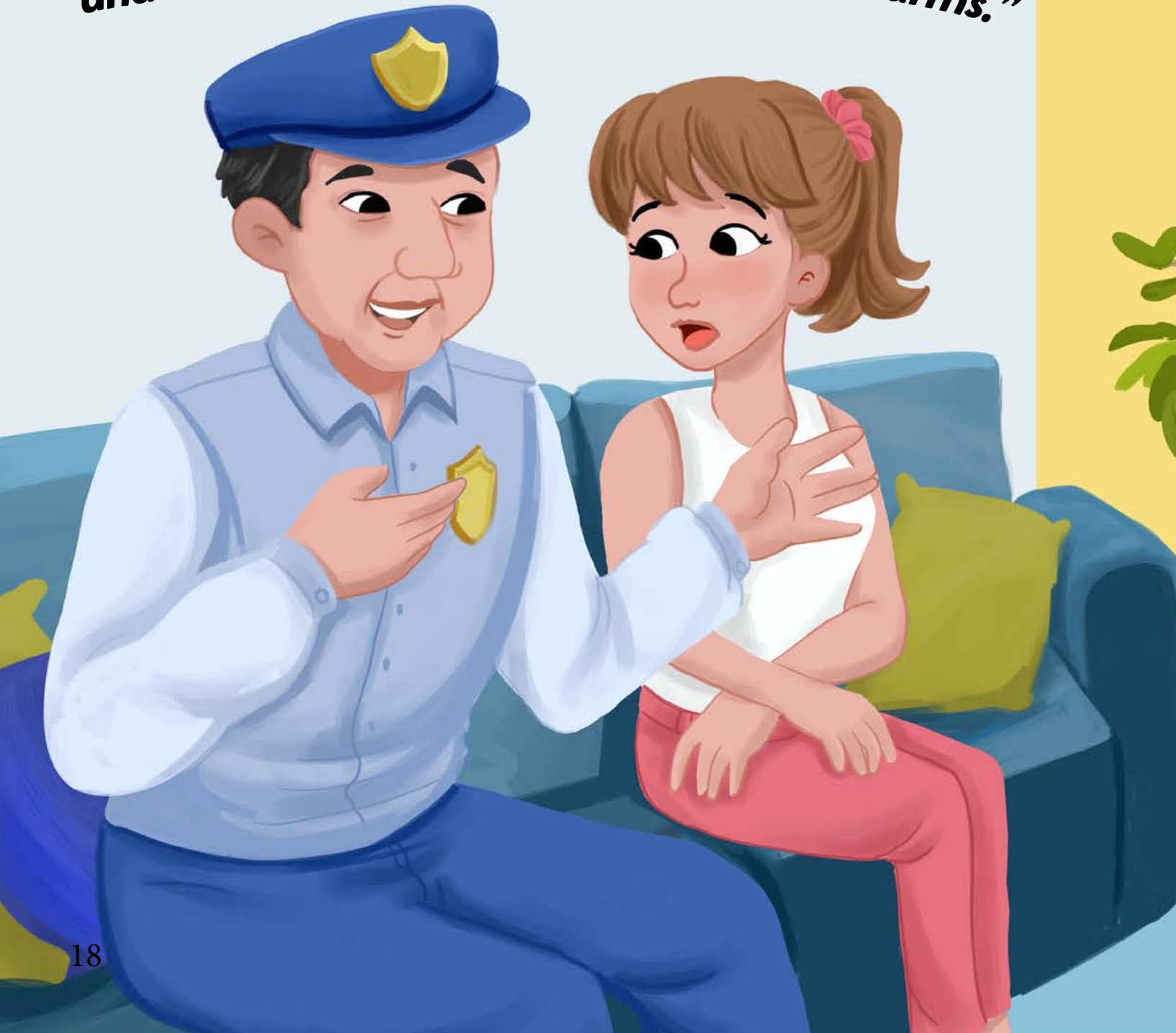


Officer Robinson gathered the children and Mr. Williams in the living room.
